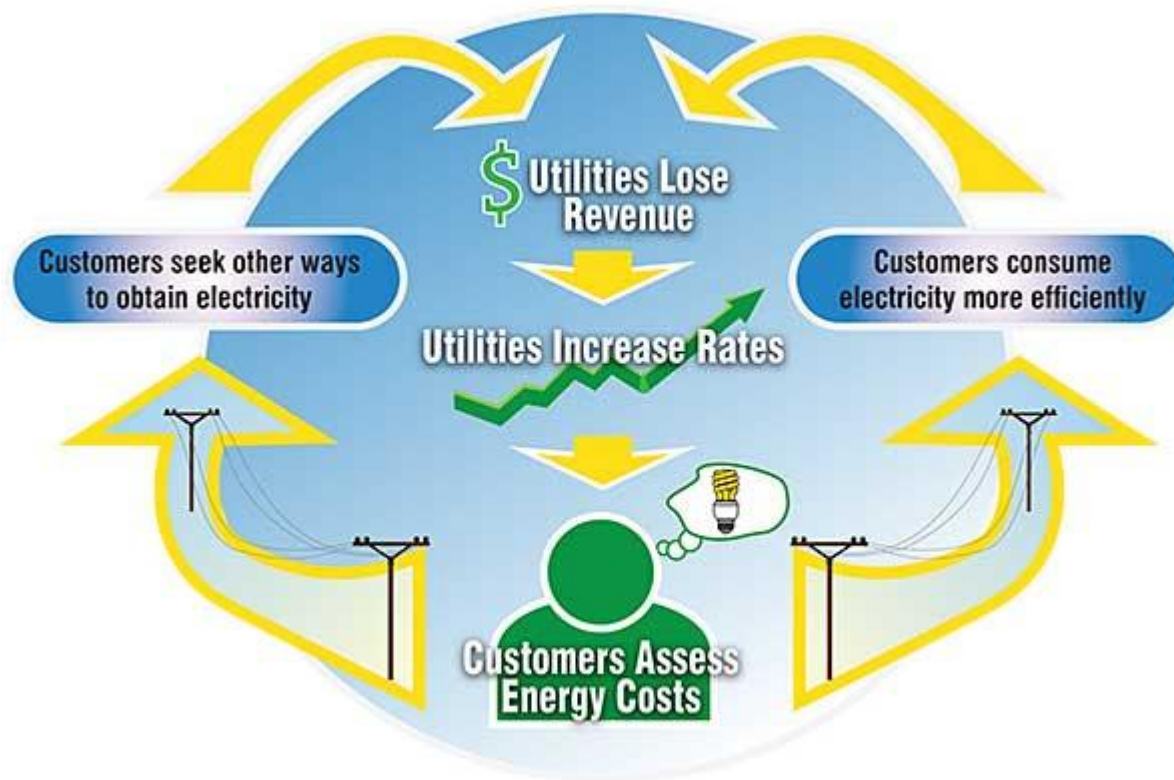

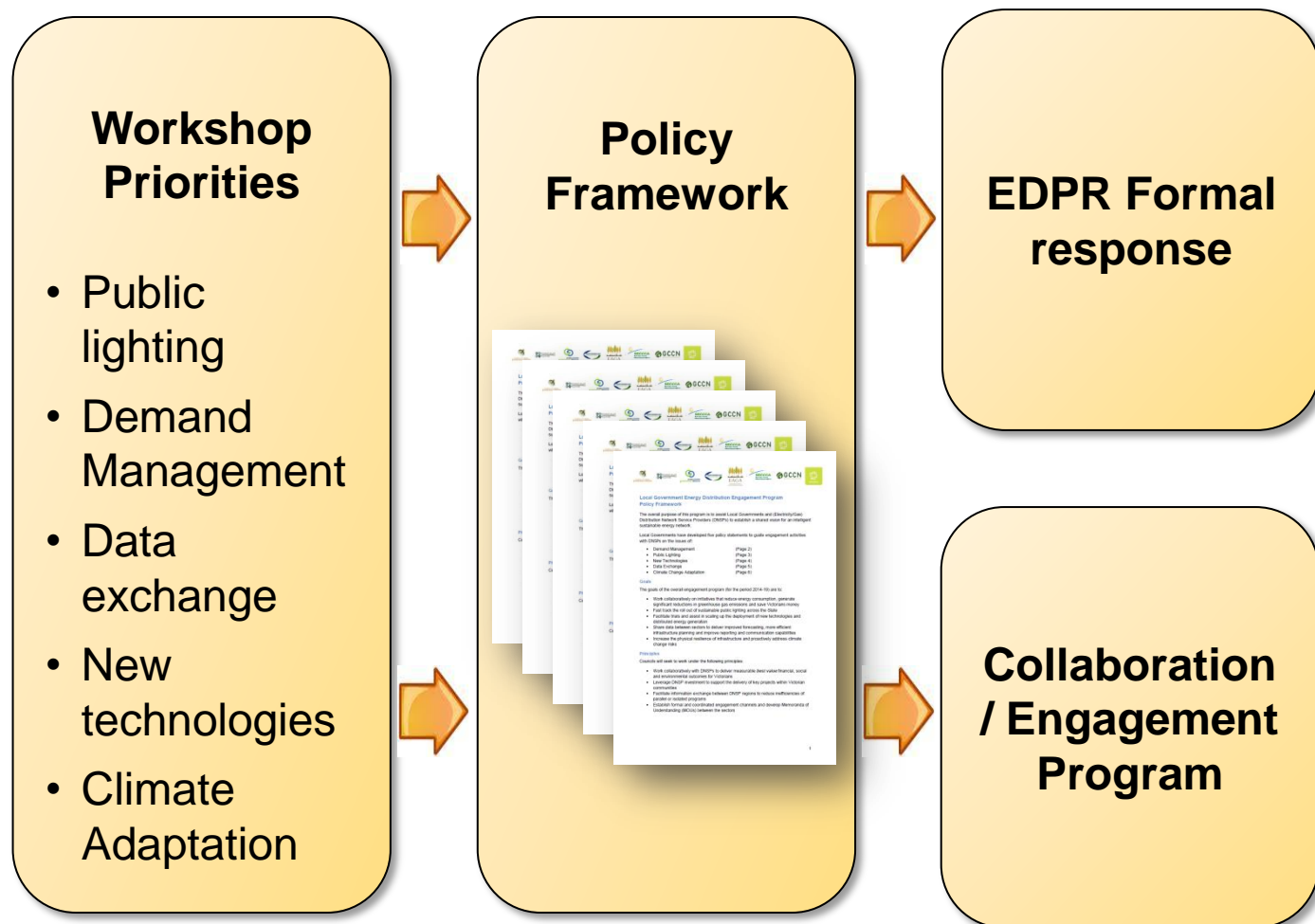


# The 'death spiral'



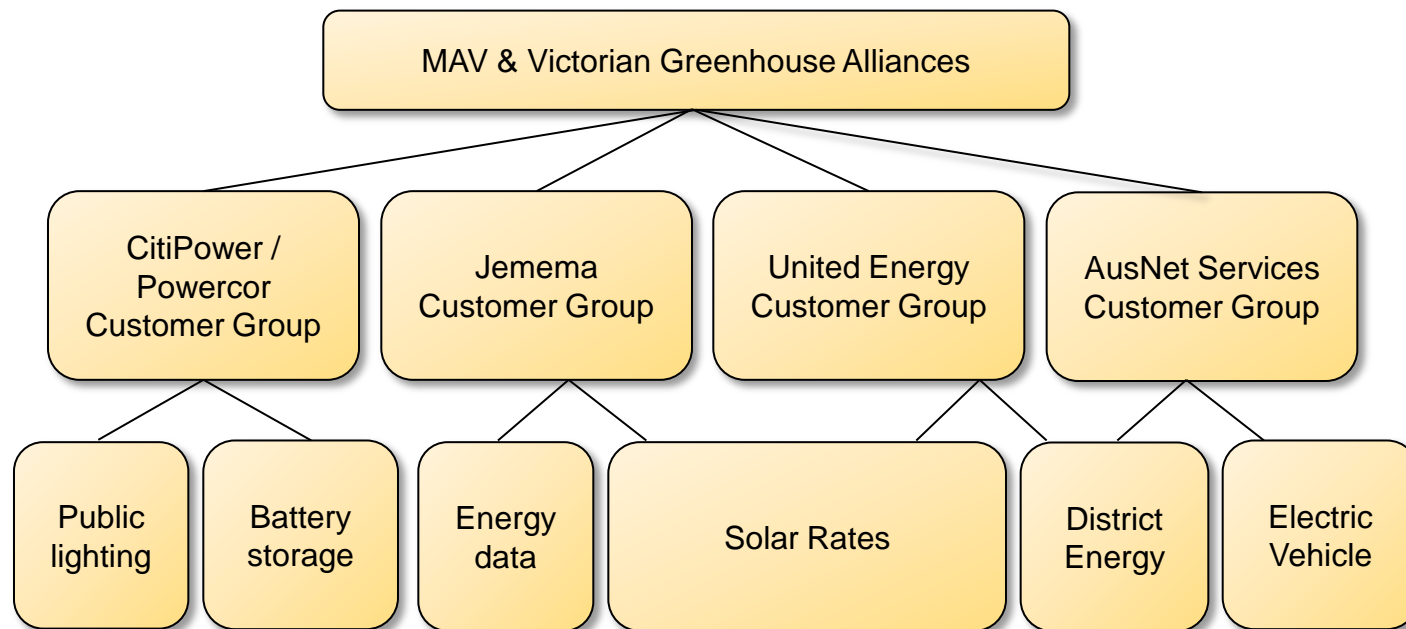

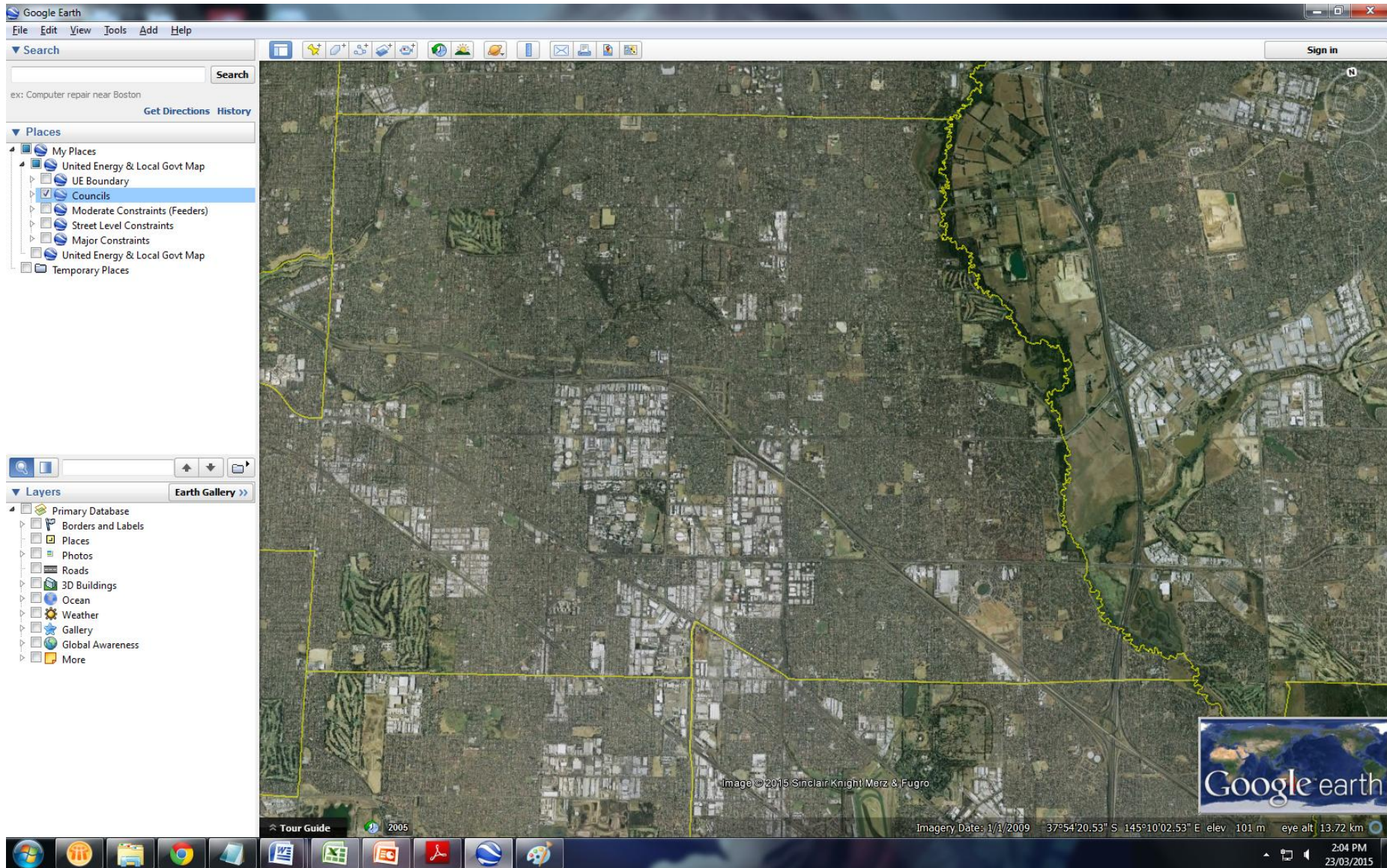
