Very Successful Collaboration – Why?



1. Strategic Drivers at MCC & UE

MCC Doncaster Hill Vision, Smart Energy Zone

UE Demand Management Strategy, UE Vision – intelligent network

2. Opportunity

Network Constraint (Doncaster / Templestowe substation – \$10M to \$15M for new substation to meet predicted 20MW demand)

3. Government Policy and Funding
AER Demand Management Incentive Scheme

OUTCOME: MOU - Strategic Partnership - Aug 2011



Benefits to Community



- Brownouts reduced more resilient networks
- Lower bills reduced energy usage & network fees smoothing of peak demand –network service and usage costs are reduced
- Incentives direct behavioural incentives (\$25 rewards)
 - to purchase new equipment eg pool motors
 PV plus storage etc



Benefits to United Energy



- Brownouts reduced more resilient networks
- Financial Savings 10% per year on estimated CAPEX approx \$1.5 M in 2015
- Progresses UE Vision provides practice field
 infrastructure investments in the order of \$millions and \$billions
 30 year project life once built
- Responding to Australian Energy Regulator requirements



Benefits to Council



- Financial Savings reduced energy costs due to thermal infrastructure and energy savings
- Projects funded through DMIS
- Human Capital and IP Strategic Partner access to United Energy's human capital and IP
- Progresses MCC objectives





Sustainability and resilience



- GHG savings
